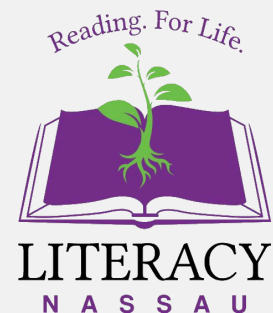

Our Services

SMALL GROUP INSTRUCTION FOR ADULT ENGLISH LANGUAGE LEARNERS

We offer beginner English language instruction. Our small group curriculum-based classes are taught by trained volunteer teachers. These classes are held in local libraries. Classes are six (6) hours total and meet twice a week. Registration for new students takes place in September.

SMALL GROUP INSTRUCTION FOR ADULT BASIC LITERACY

Adults who struggle with reading, writing, and/or spelling due to undiagnosed learning disabilities as children are offered phonics-based small group instruction using the Orton-Gillingham approach to teach decoding and encoding.

CITIZENSHIP ASSISTANCE CLASS

We host citizenship preparation classes at local libraries to help students prepare for their Naturalization exam and interview.

NEXT CHAPTER BOOK CLUB & JOT IT DOWN WRITING CLUB

Clubs offer adults with developmental disabilities the opportunity to read & write for pleasure, make new friends, and socialize in the community. Guided by a pair of trained volunteer facilitators, clubs meet weekly for an hour at over 30 libraries and cafes across Long Island.

SATURDAY ENGLISH IMMERSION PROGRAM FOR KIDS

Funded by the Guru Krupa Foundation, this program features traditional academic instruction, crafts and games to teach children the English language.



ORTON-GILLINGHAM TUTORING FOR CHILDREN

Our donation-based tutoring center provides individualized instruction to children who struggle with dyslexia and other language-based learning disabilities. Tutoring sessions are delivered by trained Orton-Gillingham practitioners. At the request of the school district, we can also provide Orton-Gillingham tutoring services in schools.
